For IV (Batch 2015) & VI Semester (Batch 2014) Regarding Summer Internship Assessment, LLB-351 & LLB - 451

All the students of IV Semester (Batch – 2015) & VI Semester (Batch – 2014) are hereby informed that the Court Diary should be submitted by **10th August, 2017**. The Internships should be done under an Advocate with not less than **5 years of standing** at the bar. You are required to undergo **Four Weeks compulsory internship**. Submit **two visiting cards of the advocate / law firm** you are interning with along with the **enrolment no. of Advocate**. Original Certificate of internship has to be produced at the time of Viva Voce. A photocopy of the same has to be attached in the Court Diary. In all, there have to be **minimum 7 cases** for the entire duration of Internship. Internships have to be done only in Delhi. For outstation students if they wish to work outside Delhi, **prior written permission of the Dean** has to be sought. In application the details of advocate / law firm should be given. The diary should contain the following particulars in your **own handwriting**.

- ❖ Index having the case no., date and page no.
- ❖ Name of the Court, Judge, Court Room Number and Designation of Judge.
- ❖ Name of the parties with their nomenclature. (Whether plaintiff, defendant etc.)
- ❖ Title of the case. (eg. Under which provision the case is being filed)
- ❖ Facts of the case in your own words in minimum 2 pages and maximum 3 pages.
- ❖ Your observation for that day.
- ❖ Next date of hearing.
- ❖ If a case comes up for hearing within the duration of Internship, the facts have to be reproduced again.
- ❖ In case a student has not been to the court and was only assigned office work then any research work (Minimum 7) done has to be written neatly in 4-5 pages specifically stating the topic, the research problem, the research tools and conclusion.
